LA MAMOUNIA, MOROCCO

With its pink skies, sultry air and mesmerizing souk (the largest in Morocco), Marrakech exudes sensuality. And there are few better places to embrace it than the legendary La Mamounia. Reopened in late 2009 after a three-year, multimillion-dollar redo, the 20-acre oasis just within the historic city walls hides walkways landscaped with jasmine and orange trees, a gorgeous tiled swimming pool — even its own vegetable and herb garden, which the chef harvests daily for use in one of the four restaurants. The 207 rooms and suites (plus three over-the-top private villas) feature ornate, storybook-esque decor ideal for honeymoons. Take the Bakdequin suite (pictured). You enter through a foyer lined with slinky couches topped with oversize pillows; from there, the French doors open to the patio looking out to the Atlas Mountains and the sparkling pool below. The centerpiece of the palatial bedroom is a canopy bed with billowing drapes in butter yellow and soft cream. And if that isn't enough, the larger of the two bathrooms (yes, there are two) steps up the sexy factor with a rain shower and claw-foot tub for two. From \$700 — Tara Bradley
